(Lectionary for Mass, no. 803)

167. Psalm 33:12 and 18, 20-21, 22

R. (5b) The earth is full of the goodness of the Lord.

Blessed the nation whose God is the LORD, the people he has chosen as his heritage. Yes, the LORD's eyes are on those who fear him, who hope in his merciful love. R.

Our soul is waiting for the LORD. He is our help and our shield. In him do our hearts find joy. We trust in his holy name. R.

May your merciful love be upon us, as we hope in you, O LORD. R.

168. Psalm 34:2-3, 4-5, 6-7, 8-9

R. (2a) I will bless the Lord at all times. or:

R. (9a) Taste and see the goodness of the Lord.

I will bless the LORD at all times, praise of him is always in my mouth. In the LORD my soul shall make its boast; the humble shall hear and be glad. R.

Glorify the LORD with me; together let us praise his name. I sought the LORD, and he answered me; from all my terrors he set me free. R.

Look toward him and be radiant; let your faces not be abashed. This lowly one called; the LORD heard, and rescued him from all his distress. R.

The angel of the LORD is encamped around those who fear him, to rescue them.

Taste and see that the LORD is good.

Blessed the man who seeks refuge in him. R.

169. Psalm 103:1-2, 8 and 13, 17-18a

R. (8a) The Lord is kind and merciful.

or:

R. (cf. 17) The Lord's kindness is everlasting to those who fear him.

Bless the LORD, O my soul, and all within me, his holy name. Bless the LORD, O my soul, and never forget all his benefits. R.

The LORD is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger and rich in mercy.

As a father has compassion on his children, the LORD's compassion is on those who fear him. R.

But the mercy of the LORD is everlasting upon those who hold him in fear, upon children's children his righteousness, for those who keep his covenant. R.

170. Psalm 112:1-2, 3-4, 5-7a, 7bc-8, 9

R. (cf. 1) Blessed the man who greatly delights in the Lord's commands.

or:

R. Alleluia.

Blessed the man who fears the LORD, who takes great delight in his commandments. His descendants shall be powerful on earth; the generation of the upright will be blest. R.

Riches and wealth are in his house; his righteousness stands firm forever. A light rises in the darkness for the upright; he is generous, merciful and righteous. R.

It goes well for the man who deals generously and lends, who conducts his affairs with justice.

He will never be moved;
forever shall the righteous be remembered.

He has no fear of evil news. R.

With a firm heart, he trusts in the LORD. With a steadfast heart he will not fear;

he will see the downfall of his foes. R.

Openhanded, he gives to the poor; his righteousness stands firm forever. His might shall be exalted in glory. R.

* 171. Psalm 128:1-2, 3, 4-5ac and 6a

R. (cf. 1) Blessed are those who fear the Lord. or:

R. (4) See how the Lord blesses those who fear him.

Blessed are all who fear the LORD, and walk in his ways! By the labor of your hands you shall eat. You will be blessed and prosper. R.

Your wife like a fruitful vine in the heart of your house; your children like shoots of the olive around your table. R.

Indeed thus shall be blessed
the man who fears the LORD.

May the LORD bless you from Zion
all the days of your life!
May you see your children's children. R.

172. Psalm 145:8-9, 10 and 15, 17-18

R. (9a) How good is the Lord to all.

The LORD is kind and full of compassion, slow to anger, abounding in mercy. How good is the LORD to all, compassionate to all his creatures. R.

All your works shall thank you, O LORD, and all your faithful ones bless you.

The eyes of all look to you, and you give them their food in due season. R.

The LORD is righteous in all his ways, and holy in all his deeds.

The LORD is close to all who call him,

who call on him in truth. R.

173. Psalm 148:1-2, 3-4, 9-10, 11-13ab, 13c-14a

R. (13a) Let all praise the name of the Lord. or:

R. Alleluia.

Praise the LORD from the heavens; praise him in the heights.
Praise him, all his angels; praise him, all his hosts. R.

Praise him, sun and moon; praise him, all shining stars. Praise him, highest heavens, and the waters above the heavens. R.

Mountains and all hills, fruit trees and all cedars, beasts, both wild and tame, creeping things and birds on the wing. R.

Kings of the earth and all peoples, princes and all judges of the earth, young men and maidens as well, the old and the young together.

Let them praise the name of the LORD, for his name alone is exalted. R.

His splendor above heaven and earth. He exalts the strength of his people. R.

That the Christian people may grow in virtue day by day and that all who are burdened by any need may receive the help of grace from above, let us pray to the Lord. R7.

That the grace of the Sacrament will be renewed by the Holy Spirit in all married persons here present, let us pray to the Lord. R7.

Graciously pour out upon this husband and wife, O Lord, the Spirit of your love, to make them one heart and one soul, so that nothing whatever may divide those you have joined and no harm come to those you have filled with your blessing.

For the Church, the holy People of God, and for unity among all Christians, let us pray to the Lord. R7.

Lord Jesus, who are present in our midst, as N. and N. seal their union accept our prayer and fill us with your Spirit.
Who live and reign for ever and ever.
